## CHRISTMAS MOVIE

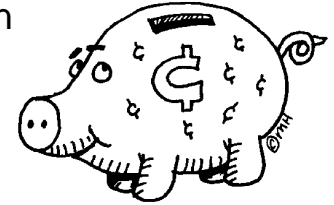
We will watch a Christmas movie all together in the gym following Christmas Caroling on Monday, December 21. The students may bring blankets and pillows if they would like.
