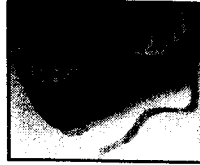

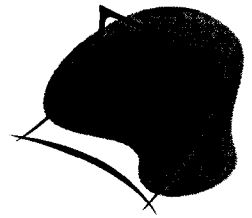


## HARBOR BEACH COMMUNITY-HOUSE OPEN HOUSE

## PTL DIRECTORY

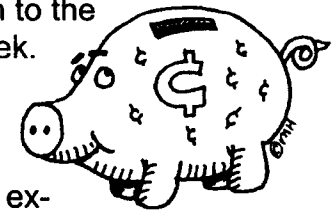
After much sweat and tears the PTL Directory is finished and is accompanying the Tiger Tracks this week.
