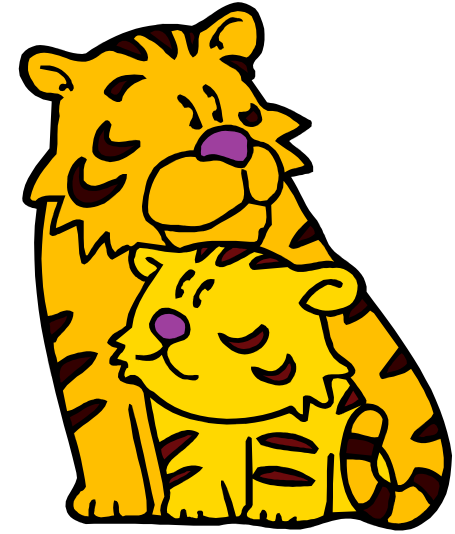

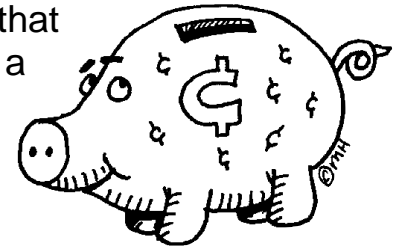
## 7TH AND 8TH GRADERS
